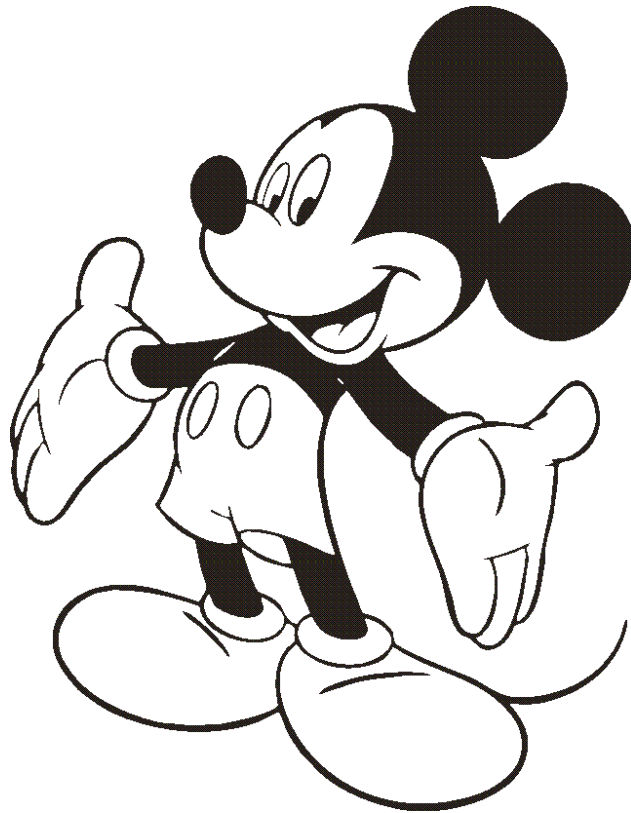

Check In Procedure: Please Read

Chaperone Instructions

Taking Attendance on the Busses

Attendance must be taken exactly this way every time we get on the busses. Please have the same person take attendance each time. This is one of the most important aspects of the trip.

Please follow these instructions to the letter

1. Use the Attendance page for that day
2. Write the date and time at the top column on the sheet, each time you take attendance.
3. Stand in the center of the bus when taking attendance, have another chaperone watch hands.
4. Call every name in alphabetical order and tell the students to raise their hands. They will get used to the order and be able to do this very quickly by the end of the trip. So will you. They must all sit.
5. Check the sheet after hearing each name.
6. The other chaperones on the bus will then each do 2 or 3 bus counts, walking down the aisle from front to back and back, to front again.
7. There must be 4 counts of the correct number of students on the bus, with the same exact number or go through the procedure again.
8. Take attendance of all the chaperones and check the sheet accordingly as a last step.

I could tell you horror stories of bands who left one student or chaperone behind, hundreds of miles from home. Please follow these instructions to the letter so there is no way that a problem will occur. Counts by themselves will not be sufficient. Names must be called and hands watched when taking attendance. This is one of the most important things that we do on this trip.

Pat's Rules for a Great Trip

1. Respect the staff & each other
2. Hands off other peoples' things
3. Be on time for everything
4. Have a good attitude
5. Keep the bus, room, & wherever you are neat and clean
6. Be nice to everyone
7. No PDA (public displays of affection) past holding hands
8. No cursing
9. LATE = GROUNDED
10. Attitude Problems = Longer Grounding
11. Don't order chaperones around, ie: "make it louder" "change the movie" "it's too cold." Walk up to the front and ask nicely "is there any way we can turn the heat up a bit" Be respectful, classy and kind!
12. Don't pass garbage to the front of the bus, walk up and put it in the bag
13. Don't even think about changing the movie order or questioning a chaperone's decision
14. No "Morale Deflators" = no dirty looks, complaining, moaning, or whining
15. Never, ever say "Are we there yet?"

Allowed on the Florida Trip

Any handheld video games. IPODs, any portable music players with headphones are ok. Cell phones are ok of course. Laptops are ok. Bring your power supplies for your cell phone and laptop onto the bus with you, there are outlets for each seat.

Not Allowed on the Florida Trip

No video games systems at all, they will be taken away. We are not going on this great trip to sit in the room and play video games. **Absolutely no boom boxes or external speaker music systems allowed. No other unauthorized electronics such as fog machines, strobe lights, special effects electronics, etc.**

Florida Trip Packing Checklist

Carry On Bag (small bag, must fit under seat or in overhead compartment, the size of a Gym Bag)

This will go on the bus with you on Friday night **and is all you will have access to until Saturday night.** These are items you will need for the bus ride. You will live out of this bag for 24 Hours.

___ inhaler (if you have asthma) Label it with your name - bring it even if you haven't had an attack for some time, (the air on the bus can get dry and stale after a while).

Note: You don't need to bring too many munchies or any sheets, sleeping bags, towels, etc. because we are staying in a hotel. You will be able to buy munchies at our rest stops.

How much money to bring?

That totally depends upon you, You will be receiving \$180 in cash during the week which should cover all your food. You will need some money for any additional snacks and souvenirs.

Out of Bounds (violating any of the following)

This is a school sponsored event, therefore smoking is not allowed at any time on this trip. Remain seated on the bus. Music players must be used with headphones. Be considerate of other guests in the hotel.

- TV, music, voice at minimum volume
- Do not run in the hallway
- Do not jump on the furniture
- Do not deface hotel property (roommates will be billed)
- Do not remove hotel property (roommates will be billed)
- Rooms must be in order at all times.
- Students may not use the hotel room phones or make any charges to their room; cable TV, room service, etc.
- Do not slam hotel room doors

All school field trip rules remain in effect during the trip.

Chaperones will **knock and search** any student's room if necessary to enforce all school rules and regulations. Chaperones also reserve the right to **check any beverage carriers**, containers, or mini coolers at any time during the trip.

Special Notes Regarding Itinerary

Courtesy, Behavior, and Restaurants Remember, the possibility of future trips will be determined by the actions of the entire group in terms of cleanliness, behavior, and courtesy. Clean the areas at all restaurants. Be aware of people around you.

Hotel Check In If students see any damage upon entering, they should notify their chaperone immediately. Students using the room will be charged for any damage found in the room at check-out.

At the Parks Students are required to stay in the assigned park or they will be sent home at their parent's expense. Anyone in a group of less than 4 will be grounded at the chaperone station for the day. In case of emergency call your chaperone or Mr. Patterson immediately.

Behavior at the Hotel Be aware of people in the hotel. Do not act loudly or behave in a fashion that will disturb others. **Be on extra special behavior after 10pm.** One phone call to the front desk will hurt our reputation.

The Long Ride, Getting to the Hotel, etc. The bus ride is long so you must be courteous to all those on the bus. Behavior is to be great at all times. Any problems or possible confrontations should be brought to the attention of a chaperone immediately. When we get to the hotel you must be patient, it will take some time to actually check in so be patient.

If you Are Sick, You Must Tell Us ! See Ms. Collins immediately.

Rules During Trip You have agreed to a set of standards established by the Roslyn School District to be a part of this trip. Please note, **students will be sent home at parent's expense** if they are found with or using alcohol or drugs, being in an opposite sex room or hazing. This rule will be strictly adhered to. Other broken rules will result in being grounded with a chaperone for a part or all of the day.

Parents picking up students Parents who are in Orlando **will not** be allowed to remove students from the park, hotel, or any part of the trip at any time. This would make it impossible for us to keep track of all band members. However, parents are encouraged to eat with us or be with the students at any of our venues. Parents may take their child while in the park or venue as long as he student remains in that park or venue.

Hazing No hazing of any kind will be tolerated.

Punctuality Do not be late for anything. Those late will be grounded at the park with a chaperone for all or part of the day

***** When you are late it causes us to make meeting times earlier which in effect takes away hours of free time.**

Chaperone Instructions

1. **Pre-trip Meeting** - We will have a pre-trip meeting for all chaperones prior to the trip. The meeting will be scheduled some day after school. We will go over this entire packet at that time. We will also arrange for parking of our cars.
2. **Assignments** - All staff members will be sleeping in rooms near their assigned students rooms, not with the students.
3. **General Chaperoning During the Day** - We are chaperoning and monitoring the students at all times in a passive way. Keep looking around and noticing everything. Any problems should be reported to Pat Patterson immediately.
4. **Medical Problems/Sick Students** All medical problems go to Ms. Collins.
5. **Moving the Students/Wake Up, Curfew** - Chaperones will be responsible for waking and moving their students in the morning and checking their rooms at night. Each chaperone will be assigned to 2 or 3 rooms.
6. **Monitoring** Generally supervise students when you are on duty, walk around or sit and relax at a good vantage point where you can see the most students.
7. **Chaperone Meetings** We will meet throughout the day to discuss any problems or concerns you have. We are a team of professionals and must work together to solve any problems as they arise.
8. **Be proactive, Our Expectations** Keep the students in check with proper positive attitudes at all times. We expect it in the band program and they all know the expectations.
9. **Emergency Problems/Attitude Problems** If there are any situations which arise in which you are uncomfortable please notify Pat Patterson. Remember, any small problems or attitude problems from students can quickly escalate.
10. **Overnight Supervision** A security guard will be on duty each night from 11pm through 6 am.
11. **Review this Entire Program** Please review this entire program. Students know these rules, we have reviewed them at great length.
12. **Smoking is Not Permitted** Under no circumstances should any student be smoking at any time. Students caught smoking will be dealt with swiftly and strictly. Notify Mr. Patterson of any violators and he will deal with them. This is a school trip and no smoking is allowed.
13. **Chaperones and Staff** Under no circumstances should any Roslyn staff member drink alcohol when on a school sanctioned trip.
14. **Food money and park tickets** The chaperones will receive food money for the week. This amounts to the equivalent of what is required to give chaperones during school trips.
15. **Souvenir Delivery** Remind students that any items purchased at any Disney stores may be delivered to the hotel store free of charge. Students can only do this up and through Wednesday. It takes a day for the items to be delivered.
